What can I do with my old computer?

Trade it in or recycle it with local organizations.

Will my Windows 10 PC stop working?

No. Your PC will continue to work, but support will be discontinued.

How is Windows 11 more secure?

Recommendations for you:

- 1. Identify if we can upgrade your current computer/s to Windows 11

- 3. Keep your current setup (Windows 10) but you will need to have managed service to make sure you don't get compromised.**
- 4. For Businesses, You must upgrade to Windows 11 to be HIPAA Compliant.**
